### **FATHER MARK WINWARD JOINING US AT ST. PAUL'S FOR THE SUMMER**

The Vestry of St. Paul's is very pleased to welcome Father Mark S. Winward to St. Paul's. Father Mark will be leading our services on the first and third Sundays of each month from June through August, 2021. Each of these services will be at St. Paul's at 9:00 a.m.

Father Mark has quite a distinguished and diverse background, having served as a career Naval officer prior to joining the priesthood. In fact, he met his wife "KC" (Kathleen) on board ship more than 34 years ago. Fr. Mark attended the Virginia Theological Seminary from 1994 to 1997 and during that time was selected to serve as an exchange student to Ridley Hall, Cambridge University. Upon ordination, Fr. Mark transferred to the U.S. Naval Reserve Chaplain Corps where he continues to serve. Fr. Mark currently serves as a Captain and the Command Chaplain at Fr. Meade. As he put it during our recent interview, he has "a full-time parish of 5,000" that he supports in his role with the military.

Father Mark's accomplishments are too voluminous to cover here, but you may be assured that the Vestry is very pleased to have a priest and person of his caliber with us for the summer.
