

Letter from the Pastor

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

There is Good News to share. First, as our Treasurer, Leslie Amtmann, closed the books on 2020 she reports that our income last year was greater than our expenses. In addition, this was achieved without financial assistance from the Diocese of Maryland which we received the three prior years, and without drawing down money from our remaining two investment accounts! Thank you, everyone, who made this achievement possible! It is the first time in at least 15 years that Christ Church has achieved this sort of financial stability. Your pledges, your contributions, and the fiscal management of our Officers and Vestry made this possible.

Next, the case numbers and the positivity numbers in Maryland, and specifically, Harford County, allows the Diocese to give us the green-light to re-open for in-church public worship. There will still be limited socially-distanced seating, masks (not bandanas) required, and the no-singing prohibition in place. We will continue the instrumental preludes at 9:45am, and some sorts of music during the services. We will continue to Live Stream the services as well. The plan is to begin on Palm Sunday, March 28. Detailed plans for Holy Week will be on the next page. We have already allowed outside groups back into the Parish Hall, also with the same Covenant Restrictions that were in place before the Diocese went into total "lock down."

In addition, I propose that with Palm Sunday and Easter (April 4) we "flip" the weekly schedule such that beginning in April we will have Holy Communion on 1st, 3rd and 5th Sundays, and Morning Prayer the 2nd and 4th Sundays. We will also continue Noonday Prayer & More Monday-Friday Live Stream at 11:55am.

As I have shared on our Sunday Morning Live Stream services, I will complete the 2nd dose of the Pfizer vaccine on Tuesday, March 16. At present, it is still best practice to continue wearing masks, practice social distancing, and washing hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds throughout the day. It is worthy of note that during these past few months, there have been few reported cases of Flu nationwide. No doubt this is due to the vigilance of following the best practices for the Covid Pandemic. This is concrete evidence that these measures, as well as limiting one's time spent indoors with crowds of people, greatly reduce viral infections from spreading.

I want to take this opportunity to once again thank our Officers, Vestry, Altar Guild and Women's Group for all the hard work that has made our continued Live Stream Worship safe and possible. In addition, we have been blessed to have the musical offerings of Marianne Kidd and Robert Hitz every week! Our experience of "being church" has in fact deepened during the Pandemic, and our appreciation of the many gifts God in Christ has bestowed on Christ Church, Forest Hill, Rock Spring Parish are many and very rich. Stay Calm. Stay Connected. Stay Church. Stay Safe. And please, when your turn comes, get vaccinated if that is at all possible for you. We will continue to work through this together and return to Church stronger for it.

We Are those People who Celebrate the Octave of Holy Week

Beginning with Palm Sunday, it has been the practice of Christians from the Church's earliest days to observe the Eight-day Festival (Octave) of Holy Week – the Days of our Lord's Passion and Resurrection. Centuries before there was a Christmas Holiday, Holy Week was, and remains, the primary Festival of the Christian Year, with many people returning to Jerusalem to walk the Stations of the Cross, and mark the days of Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter. Last year we marked the Octave of Holy Week virtually with Live Stream Worship on Face Book and on our website, <u>christchurchforesthill.org</u>. It is with great joy that it appears we will, in limited numbers and with our Covenant Restrictions in place, return to worship in our Historic 1805 Church <u>while still offering the services</u> Live Streamed.

We can only accommodate between 17 and 25 people, depending on the number of pairs of people from the same household. And we will still wear masks (no bandanas or neck gaiters), and sit at least six-feet apart, with no singing allowed. The windows will be open and the ceiling fans will be off. Marianne Kidd will play instrumental music to accompany our worship. The plan for Holy Week looks like this:

Saturday, March 27: 11:00am-12:30pm those who wish may Pick-up Palms drive-thru in the parking lot.

Sunday, March 28: A limited number of people may arrive in the church at 9:45am to listen to the Instrumental Preludes followed by the *Palm Sunday Service*.

Thursday, April 1 *Maundy Thursday*: A limited number of people may enter the church at 7:00pm for the Stripping of the Altar and Holy Communion.

Friday, April 2 *Good Friday*: At Noon we urge you to view the *Good Friday Solemn Liturgy at the National Cathedral*. <u>Click here</u>*, then scroll down to the Good Friday Service.

Sunday, April 4: 9:45am *Easter* A limited number of people may arrive for the Instrumental Preludes and Holy Eucharist.

As we are back in Phase Orange, we will continue to offer only the Bread, the Body of Christ, at Holy Communion when we return to church. Our new "No Touch" approach will be a tray with small paper cups, each with a consecrated wafer, that you may take off the tray yourself. Remember, *all services will continue to be Live Streamed on Facebook and the Christ Church Forest Hill website*. On Facebook they remain available for at least a couple of weeks, and on our website they remain available for at least 24 hours, so you may watch at any time.

Lent and Holy Week invite all Christians to Pray, Reflect and Rejoice – reflecting on the mysteries of the Last Days of our Lord's life and death, and his glorious Resurrection on Easter Day. Observing the services of Holy Week can be the most rewarding spiritual experience of the Christian Year for those who enter into the deeper meanings of each service. As we continue to live in this Time of the Coronavirus, we are urged to take the time day in Holy Week, beginning with Palm Sunday, to reflect and pray upon those events in Jerusalem that gave rise to our being those people who belong to Jesus Christ, the Son of God. When we do, the following Great Fifty Days of Easter become even more meaningful, reminding us not only who we are, but whose we are. We call ourselves Christians because we know that we are in Christ just as Christ is in us!

Christ Church Vestry Minutes January 20, 2021 [Virtual meeting via Zoom]

Attendance: Fr. Kirk, Lyn Edmunds, Leslie Amtmann, Molly Neal, Lloyd Merriam, Laurie Morris, Marianne Kidd and Kate Davis.

The meeting began at 7:05 PM with contemplative prayer.

The vestry minutes from the last meeting were approved.

Treasurer's report – the balance in our checking account is currently \$7,155; however, after payroll and upcoming bills, the balance is down to \$2,641. Supplying special envelopes in the mail for holiday collection seemed to help. So far, the total pledge income for 2021 is around \$52,000 (this is \$10,000 less than last year). The treasurer's report was approved.

Rector's report – Fr. Kirk was unable to attend the bishops/clergy meeting from today, but he will find out any guidance given from the diocese regarding Ash Wednesday. The initial plan for us on Ash Wednesday will be one service at Noon (in place of Noonday prayer) and we will explore having a drive-by distribution of ashes for a short time after the service.

In examining data from Facebook, there are a lot more viewers on our site than what appears as "attending" the live-stream services.

The Harford County Health Dept. has information on how to sign up to be in the cue to get notified of when you may schedule an appointment for the COVID-19 vaccine.

Sr. Warden's report – the donation week for the Roving Shelter is coming up the first week of February. Once we have collected donations of pre-packaged snacks/drinks, Victorious Faith will deliver them on 2/8. Molly will be updating our phone tree to use for having regular check-ins with parishioners. The 2020 annual giving statements are being prepared and will be mailed out soon.

Leslie will contact Town Security alarm company to update the points of contact in case of an emergency (the alarm system is mainly for fire protection) to David Martell, Molly Neal and Kate Davis.

The next meeting will be on 2/10 at 7:00pm.

At 8:17pm, the meeting ended with a closing prayer.

Thank you! To all of you who met and sometimes exceeded your pledges for 2020 and to those of you who gave additional gifts, thank you! I am delighted to report that for the first time in at least 16 years (maybe longer), we are in the black at the end of the year. We had about two hundred dollars more of income than expenses!

This outcome was achieved without financial aid from the Diocese, without drawing funds from our investment accounts and in spite of the fact that we have not had the benefit of hall rental and other income such as loose plate offering, kitchen sales and our usual fundraisers. Three other changes have contributed to our favorable results:

- 1) The Diocesan Allocation (money we pay to support the Diocese and its missions) is determined by calculating a percentage of the average of the last three years of operating income. After reporting accurate financial numbers for the past four years, we finally have an appropriate Allocation. (Down from \$22,800 in 2016 to \$8,895 for 2021.)
- 2) Since we are not using our buildings, utility costs are much lower.
- 3) In addition to your generosity, we received contributions from people around the country who tune in to the live-streamed Sunday and noonday services.

Once again, I thank you most sincerely for your faithful and generous support.
