
Standing Dates

- Sunday Worship: We offer three Sunday services, each with a distinct feel. At 8:00 AM we use the traditional language (called Rite I) that reminds us of the earliest days of our Anglican practice. We don't sing hymns, but our organist plays a little meditative music around Communion and at the end of the service. The 10:00 AM service features hymns for all to sing and an anthem offered by our choir. Sunday School for children from 3-18 takes place during the first half of the service, with the kids joining their families for Communion. The service at Noon welcomes our most diverse congregation, with respect to ages, backgrounds and interests. It is both meditative in feeling and light in presentation. Altar Guild prepares for services Saturdays at 9:00 AM.
- ▼ Tuesday Worship: Held in the Maryan Room at 10:00 AM, this service features a congregation gathered around a table, a homily based on the life of the Saint commemorated that day, and special prayers for healing — for ourselves or for our loved ones. Every other week the group stays to help fold and stuff newsletters for mailing.
- Every Other Tuesday Staff Meeting: Church staff and Vestry officers meet every other week at 11:00 AM to monitor church activities.
- ★ Wednesday Bible Study: Led by our Christian Education Coordinator, this program meets in the Harward Parlor on Wednesdays from 9:00 to 11:30 AM.
- Choir Practice: Thursdays at 7:00 PM & Sundays at 9:15 AM, in the Undercroft.
- 1st & 3rd Wednesday Yarn Guild: Meets from 1:00 PM to 3:00 in the Rectory to work on projects to be given away, or whatever handwork you are doing. Expert help available!
