

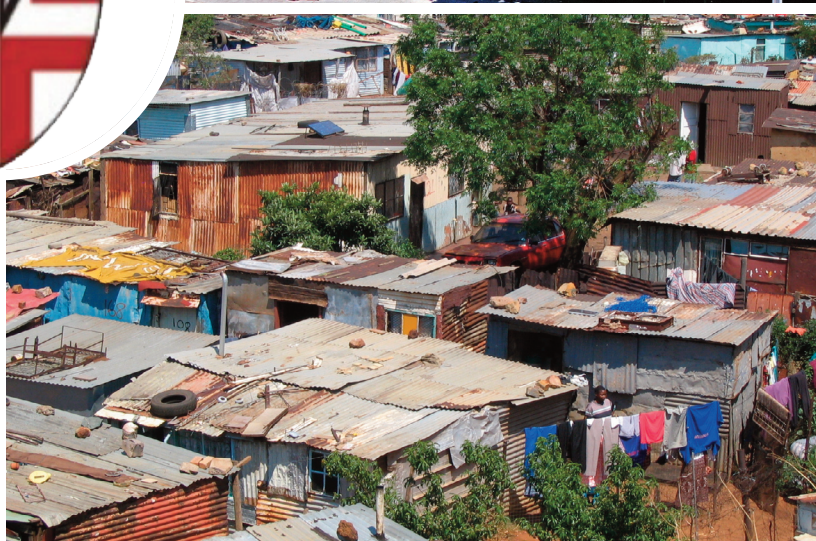
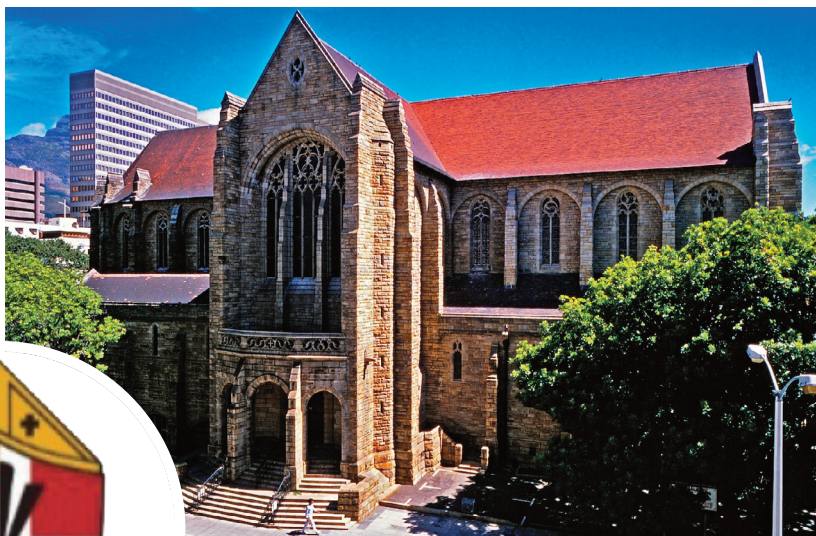

Day 1 Friday, November 6: Depart for South Africa

Depart Washington Dulles International Airport for the overnight flight to Cape Town, South Africa, via Johannesburg.

Dinner, breakfast, and beverages will be served on board. (D)

Day 2 Saturday, November 7: Arrive in Cape Town

This afternoon, arrive at Cape Town International Airport, go through Customs, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager as we exit baggage claim. Board our private touring bus and we will be on our way to Cape Town. Check-in at our hotel.

Overnight at our hotel in Cape Town. (B,L,D)

Day 3 Sunday, November 8: St. George's Cathedral | South African Museum | Table Mountain | District Six Museum

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. **Sunday service at St. George's Cathedral.** After service, we will tour the highlights of Cape Town. Enjoy a walk through the Company Gardens and proceed to the South African Museum, the oldest museum in sub-Saharan Africa. The eclectic museum houses fossils, insects, and fish; Stone Age tools over 120,000 years old; traditional clothing from sub-Saharan Africa; and much more in its diverse range of exhibitions, leaving visitors with a better understanding of the earth and its biological and cultural diversity. Packed lunch on board the coach.

Take a cable car to the top of Table Mountain, enjoying aerial views on the 10-minute ride. Proceed on a guided tour of the District Six Museum and learn about District Six, once a mixed community of freed slaves, merchants, artisans, laborers, and immigrants. The South African apartheid government forcibly removed the occupants of District Six in 1966 and declared the area a "whites-only" zone. The museum details the tragic history of the area with an impressive collection of historical materials. Return to our hotel.

Dinner at a local restaurant.
Overnight at our hotel in Cape Town. (B,L,D)

Day 4 Monday, November 9: Cape Point and Peninsula Tour

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Cape Town for our full-day Cape Point and Peninsula Tour. Travel along the Atlantic Seaboard to Hout Bay, a quaint fishing village with magnificent mountain and beach views. Continue via Chapman's Peak to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve and Cape Point, the meeting point of the Atlantic and Indian Oceans. Explore the nature reserve, filled with wild coves, shimmering tidal pools, and diverse flora and fauna. Take the Flying Dutchman Funicular railway from Cape Point, taking in the spectacular views. Lunch at a local restaurant. Return to our hotel. Free afternoon in Cape Town.

Dinner at a local restaurant.
Overnight at our hotel in Cape Town. (B,L,D)

Day 5 Tuesday, November 10: Robben Island | Highlights of Cape Town

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, transfer to the V&A Waterfront and depart on a ferry for Robben Island. The island was a training and defense station in World War II, and houses the prison where Nelson Mandela was held for 18 years. Today, it is a World Heritage Site and museum, a focal point of South African heritage. A local guide who spent time on the island during the Apartheid years will give a personal and moving account of the experience, and show us the cell where Nelson Mandela spent a large part of his life. Packed lunch on board the coach.

Continue to the Cape Flats for an afternoon visit.
Dinner and overnight at Volmoed Retreat Center. (B,L,D)

Day 6 Wednesday, November 11: Whale Watching in Hermanus | Wine Tasting in the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley

Buffet breakfast at the retreat center. This morning, we will take a day trip to Hermanus for a whale watching experience. Sail off on a catamaran from the Hermanus New Harbor. The on-board Whale Specialist will interpret the marine life encountered en-route and provide insight into the behavior of the whales you see in action. Lunch at a local restaurant.

Continue to a local wine estate in the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley and enjoy a wine tasting. A second tasting will be enjoyed at a different estate before returning to Volmoed.

Dinner and overnight at Volmoed Retreat Center. (B,L,D)

Day 7 Thursday, November 12: Spiritual Retreat in Volmoed

Buffet breakfast at the retreat center. Full day of leisure and spiritual reflection in Volmoed.

All meals and overnight at Volmoed Retreat Center. (B,L,D)

Day 8 Friday, November 13: Kapama River Lodge Safari

Buffet breakfast at the retreat center. Transfer to Cape Town International Airport for the flight to Hoedspruit. Upon arrival, continue to Kapama River Lodge. Over the next two days, enjoy an unforgettable safari experience in this spectacular region, home to Africa's big five: lion, leopard, rhinoceros, elephant, and Cape buffalo.

All meals and overnight at Kapama River Lodge. (B,L,D)

Day 9 Saturday, November 14: Kapama River Lodge Safari

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Enjoy a full-day safari experience.

All meals and overnight at Kapama River Lodge. (B,L,D)

Day 10 Sunday, November 15: Johannesburg

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Continue to Johannesburg via a flight or bus transfer (to be determined). Check-in at our hotel.

Dinner at a local restaurant.
Overnight at our hotel in Johannesburg. (B,L,D)

Day 11 Monday, November 16: Highlight Tour of Johannesburg | Mandela House | Hector Pietersen Memorial and Museum | Apartheid Museum

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, embark on a highlight tour of Johannesburg. See the northern suburbs and then continue to Soweto, the largest black residential area in South Africa. See the Chris Hani Baragwanath Hospital, Baragwanath taxi rank, Freedom Square, and Regina Mundi Catholic Church. Visit Nelson Mandela's humble house in Orlando West, where Mandela lived between 1946 and 1962. The home contains a collection of memorabilia, paintings, and photographs of the Mandela family, giving insight into the man the country fondly called "Tata" (Father). We'll also pass by the house of Bishop Desmond Tutu, which he has owned since 1975, located on the same street in Soweto as Mandela's home. Continue to the Hector Pieterse Museum, a heritage site linked to the origins of the Soweto Uprisings and its aftermath. The museum commemorates the lives of those who marched through Soweto and were shot at by police on June 16, 1976. View exhibits filled with television footage, oral testimonies, pictures, audio-visual displays, and historical documents that provide background as to the reasons for the protests while illustrating what happened in their aftermath. Lunch at a local restaurant. Visit the Apartheid Museum, examining the story of apartheid up to the first democratic elections held in 1994.

Dinner at a local restaurant.
Overnight at our hotel in Johannesburg. (B,L,D)

Day 12 Tuesday, November 17: Johannesburg | Return to the USA

Buffet breakfast at our hotel and check-out. Tour Liliesleaf Farm, the scene of the Rivonia Raid in 1963, where the leadership of the ANC were caught plotting the military overthrow of the South African government. Continue to the art district of Maboneng to see how graffiti and outdoor art is redefining the city. Visit Arts on Main, an inspiring creative hub situated in one of Johannesburg's most gentrified neighborhoods, the Maboneng Precinct. Lunch at a local restaurant.

Transfer to Johannesburg OR Tambo International Airport for our return flight to the USA. Overnight on board the flight. (B,L,D)

Day 13 Wednesday, November 18: Arrive in the USA

Early morning, arrive at Washington Dulles International Airport, overflowing with memories from our pilgrimage.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the South African Rand valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If a final payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The \$1,000.00 tour deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury. Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. We do not refund costs associated with tour services that are not utilized.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation based on availability. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: It is the traveler's responsibility to have a valid passport for international travel. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. **Parents traveling with children under 18 will be required to provide an unabridged birth certificate for all traveling children. Should just one parent travel with a child, consent in the form of an affidavit from the other parent is also required. Guardians traveling with children under 18 must produce an affidavit from the parents giving permission for the children to travel as well as an unabridged birth certificate.** It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all required documents are complete and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents, including passports.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip estimated economy class airfare from Washington Dulles. Rates will be confirmed by April 1, 2020. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). If you purchase independent connecting flights, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not independently purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed by Peter's Way Tours for travel.**

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. However, there is no guarantee that requests will be honored. Peter's Way cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available for purchase (contact our office to inquire). Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The estimated Land Only package cost is \$4,245.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$150 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package includes airfare from Cape Town to Hoedspruit and Hoedspruit to Johannesburg; it does not include transatlantic airfare or airport transfers. It is the traveler's responsibility to book the remainder of the segments independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying Peter's Way Tours in writing, up to 100 days prior to date of departure. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the group flight arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with special requests. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure (additional fees will apply). An increase in airfare may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage, per person, is included at most hotels.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on two persons sharing a hotel room with two twin beds and private facilities. Married couples may request a double bed; however, double beds are subject to availability. Triple rooms may be requested; however, there is no discount for triple occupancy. **Single rooms are limited and may be requested at time of booking. They are sometimes smaller than twin rooms and may be separated from the room block. If confirmed, an additional charge of \$950.00 will apply.** We will make every effort to accommodate roommate requests, but we cannot guarantee double occupancy. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the single supplement or prorated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast, lunch, and dinner daily, as per attached itinerary.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work, we recommend the equivalent of \$7.00 per person per day for your tour manager; \$3.00 per person per day for your bus driver; and \$2.00 per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to

leave \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others. Most pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Tour buses are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. Peter's Way Tours must be advised if a person has a disability requiring assistance. Any passenger who requires special assistance must be accompanied by a travel companion who will provide proper help. Peter's Way Tours will make reasonable attempts to accommodate disabled passengers with special needs, but shall not be held responsible if we are unable to do so. Moreover, Peter's Way Tours is not responsible for the denial of services by any carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants purchase insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for non-refundable payments, damaged luggage, or trip interruption. Peter's Way Tours offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help ensure the well-being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc (see chart below). **If the insurance premium is included with your deposit, the passenger will be covered for pre-existing conditions.** The insurance plan can be purchased at any time thereafter, excluding coverage for pre-existing conditions, until final payment has been made. **Plan payments will not be accepted after final payment has been made. All plan payments are non-refundable.** If you choose to extend your stay or embark on a pre-tour program, travel insurance can be purchased for an additional \$4.00 per day. Additional coverage needs to be requested.
