

The Gospel

I have said these things to you so that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be complete. "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends. You are my friends if you do what I command you. I do not call you servants any longer, because the servant does not know what the master is doing; but I have called you friends, because I have made known to you everything that I have heard from my Father. You did not choose me but I chose you. And I appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask him in my name. I am giving you these commands so that you may love one another.

Will you pray for them, especially in times of trouble, and celebrate with them in times of joy?

People We will.

Elizabeth and Charles, I invite you now, illumined by the Word of God and strengthened by the prayer of this community, to make your promises before God and the Church.

Charles and Elizabeth, in turn, take the right hand of the other and say

In the name of God, I, *Charles/Elizabeth* give myself to you, *Elizabeth/Charles*. I will support and care for you by the grace of God: in times of sickness, in times of health. I will hold and cherish you in the love of Christ: in times of plenty, in times of want. I will honor and keep you with the Spirit's help: in times of anguish, in times of joy, forsaking all others, as long as we both shall live. This is my solemn promise.

Blessing of Rings

Bless, O Lord, these rings to be a sign of the vows by which Elizabeth and Charles have bound themselves to each other; through Jesus Christ, our Lord. **Amen.**

Charles and Elizabeth, in turn, place the rings on each other's hands saying

Elizabeth/Charles, I give you this ring as a symbol of my vow, and with all that I am, I honor you, in the Name of the Holy and Undivided Trinity, One God.

For the honesty to acknowledge when they hurt each other, and the humility to seek each other's forgiveness and yours; Loving God, **Receive our prayer.**

For the outpouring of your love through their work and witness; Loving God, **Receive our prayer.**

For all who have been reborn and made new in the waters of Baptism; Loving God, **Receive our prayer.**

For those who lead and serve in communities of faith; Loving God, Receive our prayer.

For those who seek justice, peace, and concord among nations; Loving God, **Receive our prayer.**

For those who are sick or suffering, homeless or poor; Loving God, **Receive our prayer.**

For victims of violence and those who inflict it; Loving God, **Receive our prayer.**

For communion with all who have died, especially those whom we remember this day.
